### Master degree research project

Cryptogenic stroke means stroke with unexplained aetiology, in of cases the cause of stroke remains undetermined in spite of full investigations. Those patients are thought to have hypercoagulable state, the purpose of the study was to unmask some of the pathogenic mechanisms underlying cryptogenic stroke through assessment of some genetic disorders including C677T mutation in methylenetetrahydrofolate reductase gene and activated protein C (APC) resistance, and the role of thrombin anti-thrombin complex concentration in plasma as indicator of hypercoagulable state, the study concluded that C677T mutation in methylenetetrahydrofolate reductase gene, activated protein C (APC) resistance, thrombin anti-thrombin complex concentration in plasma are not independent risk factor for cryptogenic stroke, TAT could be used as indicator of clinical severity and prognosis in patients with non-cryptogenic stroke.

### Ph.D. Research Project

Cerebral palsy is an "umbrella term covering a group of non-progressive motor impairment syndromes secondary to lesions or anomalies of the brain arising in the early stages of its development". Stem cells are well known to be capable of differentiating into specialized cells performing different functions in the body. A stem cell transplantation (SCT) technology represents a new feasible approach to the treatment for a number of diseases including cerebral palsy. The Purpose of study was to study the impact of SCT on psychomotor functions in patients with cerebral palsy. We Concluded that Autologous stem cell transplantation could be a safe &helpful tool in the management of patients with cerebral palsy.
